



Pronghorn antelope frequent the property, and deer and elk can be found passing through. The property lies in hunting unit 86, and 160 acres allows you to apply for a landowner tag through the State of Colorado Wildlife. There are over-the-counter tags for archery elk and for some rifle seasons. Deer tags are a draw only, and pronghorn archery is over the counter, while pronghorn rifle tags are a draw as well.

From your driveway, it is a short jaunt to numerous hiking trails as well as minutes from the picturesque small town of Westcliffe & Silver Cliff. These two small historical towns offer many amenities, including great restaurant and boutique options, a grocery store, outstanding donuts, and top-notch coffee. This property is situated on the Wet Mountain Valley floor and within the Dark Sky Friendly Community of Custer County. There are panoramic views of the Sangre de Cristo Mountains and the Wet Mountains during the day and an exceptional view of the stars at night. Building sites are endless on this exquisite acreage, and access is convenient, just off a maintained county road. The lots are contiguous, allowing you to purchase 80 acres or up to 320 acres...all without covenants.

Westcliffe and Silver Cliff Weather

Climate in Westcliffe/Silver Cliff, Colorado

Westcliffe/Silver Cliff, Colorado gets 14 inches of rain, on average, per year. The US average is 38 inches of rain per year.

Westcliffe/Silver Cliff averages 86 inches of snow per year. The US average is 28 inches of snow per year.

On average, there are 260 sunny days per year in Westcliffe/Silver Cliff. The US average is 205 sunny days.

Westcliffe/Silver Cliff gets some kind of precipitation, on average, 83 days per year. Precipitation is rain, snow, sleet, or hail that falls to the ground. In order for precipitation to be counted, you have to get at least .01 inches on the ground to measure.
