Property Summary

Colorado log cabin on 36 acres bordering National Forest on 2 sides, just 10 minutes from Bayfield . No conservation easement or covenants. Direct access into tens of thousands of acres of public land with excellent mule deer, elk, bear and turkey hunting and expansive trails for hiking, horseback riding or four wheelers. This is an excellent hunting & recreational property in the HD Mountain Range of SW Colorado.

Land

The property consists of 36 acres of very usable land adjoining the San Juan National Forest on two boundaries with no covenants or HOA. The property has a mix of open meadows and rolling foothills at the base of the HD Mountain Range. The ranch is covered with Juniper and Pinion trees, scrub oak, as well as sagebrush and grassy meadows.

Improvements

The Buck Ridge Ranch has a 1,039 sq. ft. Colorado style log cabin with nice mountain views and a wraparound covered porch to enjoy your peaceful evenings while watching the abundant area resident wildlife. The cabin has a large, vaulted, log beam living, dining, kitchen area and is currently used as a studio with one bathroom, but there is space to create private bedrooms if a person wants to. It has historically been used a a very comfortable hunting cabin but is currently occupied by renters. The cabin is heated with an efficient wood stove for those brisk fall and winter evenings but also has a propane unit heater for convenience. The interior pictures of the cabin are from several years ago. Domestic water for the cabin is hauled and stored in a 1,500 gallon cistern.











There is a heated shop/bunk house building that has been used for recreational purposes and for additional sleeping quarters. The shop has a kitchen sink and a water storage tank to supply water for basic purposes. There is also an 8×12 storage shed that provides additional dry storage.

Recreation

The ranch has a variety of recreational opportunities for hunters, horseback riding, four wheelers, hiking or just enjoying the peace and quiet while watching wildlife from your covered porch. The ranch has two boundaries with the San Juan National Forest that provides excellent hunting opportunities for mule deer, elk, turkeys, bear, coyotes and a variety of small game. There is direct access to the national forest which has miles and miles of trails for 4-wheelers, horseback riding and hiking.

Region & Climate

Bayfield, Colorado, is a charming farming and ranching community nestled in the beautiful Pine River Valley. Known for its peaceful atmosphere and close-knit community, Bayfield offers a perfect blend of rural living with convenient access to outdoor adventures. 


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
