Douglas County, Kansas, has a humid continental climate with four distinct seasons. Summers are hot and humid, with July highs around 88°F and frequent thunderstorms. Winters are cold, with January temperatures averaging 40°F during the day and 20°F at night, along with moderate snowfall. Spring and fall bring milder temperatures, though spring is wetter and prone to storms. The area receives about 39 inches of annual rainfall, mostly between April and September, and experiences occasional severe weather, including tornadoes, especially in spring.


#### Location
