PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT A NEW WELL

ISSUANCE OF THIS PERMIT DOES NOT CONFER A WATER RIGHT

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

- 1) This well shall be used in such a way as to cause no material injury to existing water rights. The issuance of this permit does not ensure that no injury will occur to another vested water right or preclude another owner of a vested water right from seeking relief in a civil court action.
- 2) The construction of this well shall be in compliance with the Water Well Construction Rules 2 CCR 402-2, unless approval of a variance has been granted by the State Board of Examiners of Water Well Construction and Pump Installation Contractors in accordance with Rule 18.
- 3) Approved pursuant to CRS 37-90-105 for a well on a tract of land of 40 acres the NE1/4 of the SE1/4 of Section 34, Township 6 South, Range 59 West of the Sixth P.M., Elbert County.
- 4) Water from this well may be used for domestic purposes inside 3 single family dwellings, and the watering of the owner's own large non-commercial domestic animals.
- 5) The irrigated area shall not exceed 1 acre of lawn and garden.
- 6) Water from this well may be used for the watering of livestock on range and pasture.
- 7) The pumping rate of this well shall not exceed 15 GPM.
- 8) The annual withdrawal of groundwater from this well shall not exceed 3 acre-feet.
- 9) Production is limited to the alluvium of Bijou Creek or its tributaries. The depth of this well shall not exceed 50 feet or the depth at which sandstone or shale or other bedrock material is first encountered.
- 10) This well shall be constructed within 200 feet of the location specified on this permit.

NOTE: This permit will expire on the expiration date unless the well is constructed by that date. A Well Construction and Yield Estimate Report (GWS-31) must be submitted to the Division of Water Resources to verify the well has been constructed. An extension of the expiration date may be available. Contact the DWR for additional information or refer to the extension request form (GWS-64) available at: dwr.colorado.gov
