

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

Top it off knowing the neighboring property owners are working the same wildlife management practices bringing the total to over 2200 contiguous fair-chase acres under strict QDM, creating an amazing environment of thriving populations of deer, strutting eastern gobblers and quail



Trophy Deer and Spring Turkey Hunting

Kentucky offers the deer hunting enthusiast many hunt method options and seasons including archery/crossbow, muzzleloader, and rifle. Early archery/crossbow begins the first Saturday of September and offers the unique opportunity to hunt mature velvet bucks while still in their summer patterns. Kentucky offers one of the longest hunting seasons from September through mid-January


Hunting licenses are available over-the-counter in Kentucky allowing the owner and guests the convenience and peace of mind for planning each season afield. The one buck per year rule in the state of Kentucky allows bucks the necessary time to fully mature. These factors combined with quality deer management (QDM) practices provides the ideal formula for an incredibly rewarding hunting experience

Spring turkey season for the fired-up, strutting eastern gobbler is absolutely amazing and unrivaled. The springtime green-up is truly a spectacular time to be outdoors in Kentucky during a three-week period from mid-April through the first weekend of May

Region & Climate

North Central Kentucky experiences 4 distinct seasons of weather. Springtime green-up is beautiful with comfortable daytime temperatures in the 60's and 70's. Summertime highs range from the high 70's to mid 80's making it ideal for enjoying action-packed fishing on the private ponds for jumbo largemouth bass and thick shouldered crappie

Fall colors are gorgeous, and as the nights turn cooler and the leaves begin to change from green to many vibrant colors, Fall in Kentucky is a heavy favorite boasting comfortable daytime temperatures in the 60's and 70's plus cool comfortable nights in the 40's and 50's. Winter is moderate by most standards boasting daytime temperatures in the mid to upper 40's and nighttime lows in the 30's and 40's, with the rare, but seemingly always welcomed light snowfall


